#### **Howard Nurseries**

Wortham plant specialists Howard Nurseries scooped two awards at the Waterwise Water Efficiency Awards at the House of Lords recently, in recognition of their self-sufficient water management system. The Waterwise biannual UK Water Efficiency Awards are the most high profile awards scheme in the UK to recognise the water efficiency achievements of the public, private and third sector organisations who promote water efficiency. The Nurseries won the Environment Agency Chairman's Award and the Farming and Horticulture Award for their reservoir which has 5,000 reeds and 10,000 fish.

## **Royal British Legion Women's Section**

Sadly the RBLWS is to be disbanded later this year. The Women's Section was formed in 1921 and today has about 30,000 members in more than 700 branches. Eye and Botesdale branches have decided to disband and both standards will be laid up.
